With all phases of the manufacturing process completed on-site in Portlandville, New York, Wightman's ensures customers superior quality wood materials.

## The process


- Raw materials are sourced from within 60 miles of Wightman's mill.
- Bark is removed and logs are sawn into boards of lumber.
- All by-products of the sawing process are utilized in operations at Wightman's or are sold to local businesses.
- Lumber is dried in on-site kilns.
- National Hardwood Lumber Association standards are used to determine lumber grade.
- Lumber is processed through state-ofthe-art moulding equipment to shape finished materials.






Wightman's Cherry, Red Oak and Primed wainscot and beadboard materials feature reversible profiles, allowing for either single or double beads.




